**Extended Activity:** Making a Tipping Tea Kettle

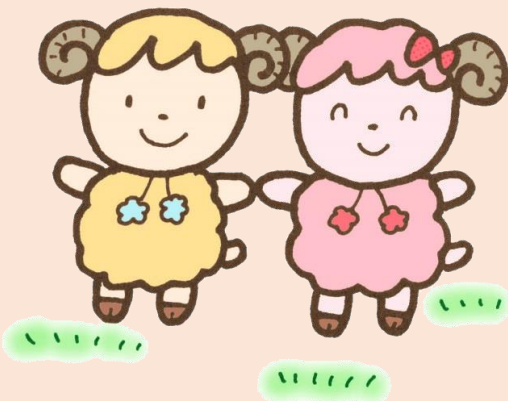
### Mary Has a Little Goat
